

## **WAYPOINT SPRING CAMP, 17<sup>th</sup> - 19<sup>th</sup> May 2024**

**What is the Spring Camp:** If you like the idea of a very relaxed informal time away as a Church family, then you will love this! A great chance to spend quality time together with evening communal meals, entertainment, organised challenges, large games of volleyball (optional!) and more.

**Food:** Breakfast and lunch you will need to supply for yourself/your family (there is a kitchen facility onsite, with microwave, fridge, freezer, boiling water and toasters). We recommend you bring a cool box and perhaps a camping stove. (Lots of local eating options if you have a car). We will have an evening communal meal together on Friday and Saturday, and a BBQ lunch on Sunday (included in cost).

**Where:** Lockerley Water Farm, Romsey, SO51 0LW situated only 15 minutes from Southampton and Winchester and 10 minutes from Mottisfont.

**Who is it for:** Anyone! Families, singles, couples, young or old (to attend without a parent you need to be 15+ and in a group of 4 or more)

**When:** Friday 17<sup>th</sup> May 6pm until Sunday 19<sup>th</sup> May 3pm.

### **Accommodation:**

**Lodges:** There are 4 purpose built units which can sleep up to 10 people in each unit and can be divided into two (a group of 5 or a family could share) Each lodge has a toilet. This would be more suited to families.

**Sleeping Cabins:** There are 8 cabins available, each cabin has 5 pairs of bunk beds and can therefore sleep up to 10 people in each cabin. Please note there are no dividers in the cabins (suitable for groups or youth).

**Field:** The field has ample space for people to set up their own tents or caravans and there are electric hook up points on the field.

**Shower blocks** and communal toilets onsite (v. good condition)

**First come first served:** If you want a lodge or cabin we recommend you return your booking form asap. We are unable to reserve any accommodation. Likewise, hook up points are first come first served.

### **What to expect (typical timetable)**

**9am** Devotion (optional) A time for us to come together, pray and be led in a thought for the day.

**9.30am onwards** The rest of your morning/breakfast and lunchtime is over to you! There is an indoor activity space, table tennis tables, outdoor volleyball/football pitches. You are allowed offsite! Or you can just chill out with others onsite. Youth programme available

**5.30pm** Communal meal - Come join us for a big dinner! E.g. BBQ

**Evening** Quizzes/films/mini challenges and more

**8.30pm** Campfire worship - hot chocolate - marshmallows!
